To all our Lambda Chi Brothers, Wives, and Friends who enjoyed the past 34 years in beautiful vistas of mountains, lakes, landscapes, and golf courses from the Catskills to the Poconos, we, the LXA ('42 to '65) "Roscoe" Reunion Group are gathering again after five years at Skytop ... but this year in Wellsville New York in conjunction with the Alfred University Alumni Reunion.

Times are changing for the "Reunion" and we enter a new phase. With many of the founders and regulars getting older and fewer of the newer class members joining us, we're "downsizing" for 2014. We opt for a smaller lower cost venue, with 100% fine accommodations, reasonable fine food, private dining, a golf match at the local Wellsville Country Club plus the advantage of selecting and enjoying events and features that we will find at the nearby Alfred University Alumni Reunion.

The dates are June 5, 6, 7, with departure on Sunday, June 8, 2014

We have reserved 18 rooms at the Microtel Inn & Suites in Wellsville that are available through May 1st before they are cancelled. Rates range from \$71.99 for a single queen bed to \$80.99 for two queen beds in a room. The phone is (585) 593-3449. We have reserved Thursday and Friday evening dinners at The Beef Haus Restaurant (<http://www.beefhaus.com/>) for our group. It is just down the street from the Motel and the Golf Course is further down the end of Main Street.

Alumni Golf Tournament: Noon, Friday June 6, 2014, Wellsville Country Club; Scramble Format. A fee of \$75 includes lunch on course plus strategically placed beer kegs. The entrance fee benefits the AU Football program. Prizes are available with side bet opportunities. Joe, Erf, Bruce, Bill Dick, Bill Crandall, and Walt and Linda Reed among others, have played there before. It's a nice course and convenient to our motel.

Registration for the AU events on Saturday can be made through AU Alumni Relations: Web; <mailto:alumni@alfred.edu> or phone 607-871-2527, the direct line for Audrea Sinanni who can make sure you get the Golden Saxon discounts since all of our people are Golden Saxons. The online registration process does not automatically give Golden Saxon discounts so best to talk with Audrea. She will sign you up for the events which for some will include the golf scramble, and for most will be the Saturday lunch, Saturday evening Golden Saxons dinner, and perhaps beer tasting and photos. There is a 50% Golden Saxons discount on campus meals. It also applies to campus lodging (which I doubt anyone wants). The discount does not apply to Golf, Photos, 5K, or Beer Tasting. Registration for golf can be as individual or foursome. Let us know if you signed up for golf and Bill Dick, Bruce and I will arrange foursomes.

I want to encourage all of you to attend if at all possible.
