# Matching Fund

As with any building, age takes its toll. The house turned 25 years old this year and like most houses of its age is in need of new windows. The original Pella windows have more than served us. Over the past 7 years we have spent over \$6,000.00 repairing and adjusting the windows. Unfortunately this will no longer do the trick. Frames are rotting and warping resulting in the inablility to close and lock them. This has caused not only a security issue but also a major heat loss.

This summer we will begin a 3 year project to replace all of the casement widows throughout the house. All windows will be rated and prioritized according to condition. The look of the house will change slightly as we will be going to a slightly different window that will serve us better. The new windows will slide open with the screen on the outside. This will eliminate the need for adjustments on the cranks and latches. The double hung windows in the old Chapter room and in the party room will remain. They are still repairable and in fairly good condition. The Send your donations to: estimated cost will be about \$20,000.00.

We need your help. In order to complete this project over the next three yearss we need alumni donations. The adopt a window program will enable us to offset some of the costs. You can designate what room you would like your donation to go to and when the window is installed a placque will be put up nameing those who contributed to the replacement of that particular window.
